Application Process

1. The applicant must submit a completed Veteran or Active Duty Non-Resident Tuition Residency Exception Application to the UAMS Office of the Registrar by the published deadline for the term the applicant is requesting the waiver.

2. The applicant must provide an acceptable form of legal documentation regarding veteran status, which establishes eligibility (a minimum of 90 days of service and discharge within three years of expected date of enrollment) or active duty orders.

3. The Registrar will verify the application and documentation.

4. The non-resident tuition residency exception will be valid for every term in which the student enrolls until she/he completes or leaves the program, provided the student remains in good standing.

5. Amount of the non-resident tuition residency exception: The non-resident tuition residency exception will reduce the amount of tuition from the non-resident tuition rate to the resident tuition rate for the program to which the applicant has been accepted.

6. This non-resident tuition residency exception cannot be used as cash or as a credit to a student's account, only as a reduction in the amount/debt payable to UAMS for tuition at the in-state rate.

7. No other tuition waiver or exception programs can be applied at the same time to compound the tuition reduction. ****Employee Tuition Discounts are not tuition waivers and can be applied to the post-waiver amount of tuition.****

8. Awards are not automatically transferable from one program to another or from one college to another. However, a waiver granted by one program/college does not disqualify a student from being eligible to apply to a second program/college.

Veteran - DD214 (Military Separation Record) or Active Duty Orders

Spouse – DD214 (Military Separation Record) or Active Duty Orders and Marriage License

Dependent – DD214 (Military Separation Record) or Active Duty Orders and Tax Return Reporting Dependent
